Here at The Chabad House, we know that pleasure and purpose are both hardwired into the human condition, and that they are not mutually exclusive.


Our various programs strive to make that which is pleasurable purposeful and that which is meaningful pleasurable.

classes to Cteen to the Center City Jewish Preschool, where Rabbi Goldman and his wife Leah and their staff serve the community with heart and soul.





PERSONAL MESSAGE FROM REBBETZIN HINDEL LEVITIN

I was about nine years old when I witnessed the scene, one of dozens of times. I managed to get to the front! My face pressed hard against the glass window, partly because I wanted to see the scene below, but also because of the sheer volume of women and girls behind me, the crowd pressing me forward. 
